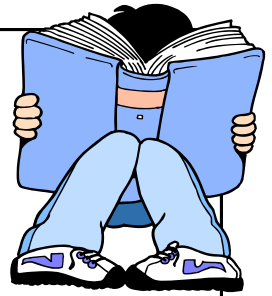

FCAT for Math, Reading, and Science in Grades 3-5

Begins Tuesday, April 11, 2011

Parents, encourage your child with these tips.

Find information in the reading or science passage to help you answer your question.

Choose the best answer to a question. Several choices may seem good, but one is always best.

Answer every question, even if you have to guess.

Take time to read the whole passage or problem and all the answers.

Stay calm. When you first read a question, you may think that you don't understand it. Reread, underline, or draw pictures to help.

Underline key words to help you understand the question. (How much is left? Which person did not do something? Which event happened last?)

Check back over your answers if you finish early. Be sure that you answer what is asked and that you did not make errors if the question is a math problem.

Clues in the passage or problem help you figure out key words.

Eat a good breakfast with plenty of protein the morning of the test.

Sleep well the night before the test. Go to bed early and get plenty of rest.
